



The Belleville Police Service is accepting applications for the position of Auxiliary Constable. Reporting to the Coordinator of Auxiliary Constable program, this position allows members to participate in Police Training, Patrol with Police Officers, Community Events and Emergency Situations.

Minimum requirements:

- at least 18 years of age
- a Canadian citizen or legally eligible to work in Canada
- successful completion of at least four years of secondary school education or its equivalent
- valid Class G driver's license (full privileges)
- good moral character and habits

Applicants will be required to meet appropriate fitness standards as set out by the Ontario Police Fitness Award Program. The position will include Police Training, with a minimum 12 hours per month expected.
